








Roles of Chartered Accountants in Employment




Roles of Chartered Accountants in Practice

Requirements for Passing Foundation Examination

A candidate is declared to have passed the Foundation examination, if he obtains at one sitting a minimum of 40% marks in each paper and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers.

Paper Numbers 1 & 2 will be subjective type while paper numbers 3 & 4 will be objective type with negative marking.

Candidate shall be admitted to Foundation Examination, if:

- A) He is registered on or before 4 months prior to the month of Foundation Examination to be held in the month of May/November or June/December respectively as decided by the Council and
- B) He has appeared in Senior Secondary (10+2) examination conducted by an examining body constituted by law in India or an examination is recognized by the Central Government or the State Government as equivalent there to.

Requirements for Passing Intermediate Examination

1. A student shall ordinarily be declared to have passed in both the Groups simultaneously, if he:

- A) Secures at one sitting a minimum of 40% marks in each paper of each of the Groups, viz, Group-I and Group-II, and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of each of the Groups. Or
- B) Secures at one sitting a minimum of 40% marks in each paper of both the Groups, viz., Group-I and Group-II and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of both the Groups taken together.\

2. A student shall be declared to have passed in a Group if he:

A) Secures at one sitting a minimum of 40% marks in each paper of Group and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of that Group.

Registration Process

Students after qualifying Intermediate Examination have to register for Final Course. At the time of registration of Final Course, students would be required to register for Self-Paced Online Module also. The form for Final Course registration will contain the facility to opt for the subject under Self-Paced Online Module Set C and Set D. No separate fee is payable for registration of Self-Paced Online Modules, namely, SETS A, B, C and D.

Requirements for Passing Final Examination

A candidate may appears in both the groups simultaneously or in one group one examination and in the remaining group at any subsequent examination. He is declared to have passed the final examination, if passes both the groups

- 1) A candidate shall ordinarily be declared to have passed in both the groups simultaneously, if he-
- a) Secures at one sitting a minimum of 40% marks in each paper of each of the groups and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of each of the groups Or
- b) Secures at one sitting a minimum of 40% marks in each paper of both the groups and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of both the groups taken together.
- 2) A candidate shall be declared to have passed in a group if he-
- a) Secures at one sitting a minimum 40% marks in each paper of group and minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of that group.







Kumar Mangalam Birla is the Chairman of Aditya Birla Group, one of the largest global conglomerates in India. He is also a philanthropist and billionaire industrialist. He regularly contributes for public causes like better health and education facilities for weaker sections of society. Only a few people are aware that he is a Chartered Accountant with an MBA from London Business College



Aman Gupta is the CEO and co-founder of BoAT Company. His company also circulates a variety of electronic gadgets such as smartwatches, headphones, earbuds, earphones, and much other equipment in this market. Despite this, he completed his CA in 2002 and become one of India's youngest CAs. After completing CA he joined Citibank and worked there as an Assistant Manager till 2005. In September 2005 along with his father, Aman started a new business named Advanced Tele media Pvt Ltd.



Deepak Parekh is an Indian businessman and Chairman of HDFC Group. HDFC is India's leading housing finance company. A man with a mission, Mr. Parekh believes that if a company earns, it must also return to the society and that companies owe a responsibility not just to shareholders, but also to all its stakeholders. Mr. Parekh is associated with Indo-US CEO Forum, City of London — Finance Committee, India-UK Financial Partnership (IUKFP), in an advisory capacity. Government and Industry impressed by Mr. Parekh's performance have honored him with several awards like the Padma Bhushan in 2006.

Famous Personalities from CA Feild



Naina Lal Kidwai is an Indian banker, Chartered Accountant and business executive. She is the Country-Head and Group General Manager of HSBC India (Hong Kong and Shanghai Banking Corporation). She was the first Indian woman to graduate from the prestigious Harvard Business School. She is an inspiration to many women in India. The Government of India has honored her with Padma Shri.



Motilal Oswal is the Founder and Managing Director of Motilal Oswal Financial Services Ltd. He is a Chartered Accountant who started his business in 1987. CA Motilal Oswal was awarded the "RashtriyaSamman Patra" by the Government of India for being amongst the highest Income Tax payers in the country for a period of 5 years. The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India gave Mr. Oswal with the "Excellent Business Achiever in Financial Services" award.



Nirmal Jain is an Indian billionaire businessman. He is the Founder and Chairman of India Infoline Group (IIFL – India Infoline Finance Ltd), a financial conglomerate and investment company. But very few know that he is the fellow member of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. He has also done his post-graduation from IIM, Ahmedabad. He started his career in 1989 with Hindustan Unilever Limited and thereafter, commenced IIFL Group in 1995. It started as an independent equity research company in India.



Radhe Shyam Agarwal is one of the most famous entrepreneurs in the country. He is the Co-founder and Executive Chairman of the Emami Group, a global group of company engaged in the business of FMCG, paper, real estate, edible oils, health care and cement. He is not only a Chartered Accountant but also a Company Secretary. He graduated from Kolkata's St. Xavier's College and had also pursued LLB and M.Com from Calcutta University



T.N. Manoharan is a chartered accountant, who also reigned as the former president of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. He was also an Ex-chairman of Canara Bank, the fourth largest public sector bank in India. He has been honoured with the most reputable award Padma Shree in 2010.

In 2009, Manoharan was one of the six members (as representatives of Government of India) appointed to the board of the scandal hit information technology company Satyam Computer Services for restructuring the company.



Dhivya Suryadevara is a Chennai-born who pursued CA and was also appointed as the very first woman CFO of General Motors. She also started her career as Chartered Financial Analyst as World Bank intern.



Vishakha Mulye is the Executive Director of ICICI bank. She is a successful CA and also headed the team which planned and executed the merger of ICICI in 2002.

Answer : Fee for registration in both the groups of Intermediate Course is Rs.18,000/-.

Question 9: I wish to appear in one of the groups of Intermediate Examination at a time. Can I register for one group of Intermediate

Course?

Answer : You can appear in one of the groups of Intermediate Examination at a time but you need to register for both the groups of

Intermediate Course.

Question10: Is there negative marking in MCQ based questions in Intermediate Examination?

Answer : There is no negative marking in MCQ based questions in Intermediate Examination.




