## Admission Process

### How to Take Admission

- ◆ DIRECT ADMISSION subject to minimum eligibility as given in Information Leaflet (Academic Session 2013-14) of Commerce Division.
- ◆ Deposit the filled-in application form at Resonance Front Office along with applicable course fee through Bank Demand Draft in favour of 'Resonance' payable at Kota. The complete course fee has to be deposited at the time of admission only.

### How to Deposit the Fee

**General:** The Course Fee should be paid to Resonance Eduventures Pvt. Ltd. All the students who have been admitted in Resonance can deposit their Course Fee for the Academic Session 2013-2014 through the following ways:

The Students have been given Bank Fee Deposition Challan in the Admission Packet for depositing fee at any of the branches of SBI/CBI/AXIS Bank across India.

#### NOTE:

- ◆ The student will have to submit the original copy of Bank Challan '**Student's Copy for Institute**' at the time of admission. The final responsibility of communicating the information of fee deposition to the institute lies with the students only.
- ◆ Students must ensure that at the time of submission of the challan's copy to the institute, **Branch Code** and **Journal Number** must be mentioned on it. This journal number would be issued by the Bank.
- ◆ The student should preserve the original copy of fee deposition (it may be Challan Copy/ Bank Receipt or the Receipt issued by institute) throughout the academic session. The student may be asked to produce it as and when required in the institute.

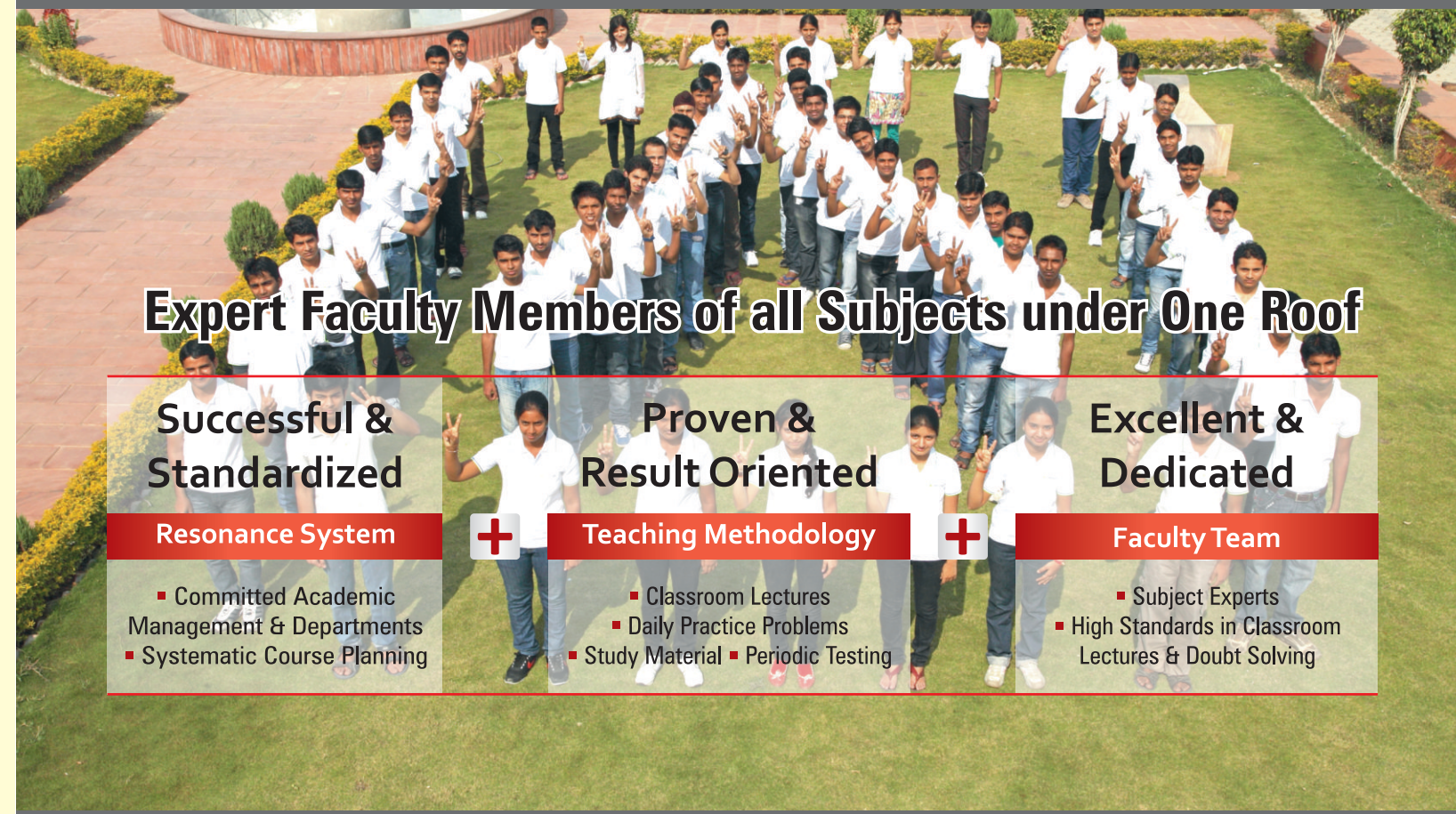

**Chartered Accountancy** is a rewarding profession where one can practice his/her own or can do jobs in various public and private sector companies. The areas of work include accounting, auditing, corporate finance, project evaluation, company and other business laws, taxation and corporate governance.

## Institute of Chartered Accountant of India (ICAI)

About ICAI - The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) is a statutory body established under the Chartered Accountants Act, 1949 (Act No. XXXVIII of 1949) for the regulation of the profession of Chartered Accountants in India. During its 61 years of existence, ICAI has achieved recognition as a premier accounting body not only in the country but also globally, for its contribution in the fields of education, professional development, maintenance of high accounting, auditing and ethical standards. ICAI now is the second largest accounting body in the whole world.

## CHARTERED ACCOUNTANCY COURSE AT A GLANCE

The course of Chartered Accountancy comprises of three levels:

1. Entrance (CPT) 2. Intermediate 3. Final

Along with articleship training of 3 years

**Total Duration of the Course: Four years after 12th**

**Eligibility:** Student must be 12th Pass out in any discipline & with any percentage.

**ENTRANCE LEVEL: Common Proficiency Test [C.P.T.]**

This is a gateway to the course of Chartered Accountancy. A Student is eligible to register for the same just after passing class X & can appear for the test after passing/ appearing class XII.

**Some of the features of the Course are:**

- Student need to register for the course by filling a simple application form costing Rs. 100/-. The registration fee for the same is Rs. 6000/-
- Exam will be held twice in a year (June, December). Cut off dates for getting registrations are as follows: For December Exams (1st October) & For June Exams (1st April)
- Paper will be objective type and of 200 Marks.
- Course will be comprises of four subject divided into two session (two hours each) of 100 Marks each for the test

Session I : Section 1 : Fundamentals of Accounting (60 Marks)  
Section 2 : Mercantile Law (40Marks)

Session II: Section 3 : General Economics (50 Marks)  
Section 4 : Quantitative Aptitude (50 Marks)

- There will be 100 question of 1 Marks in each session with negative marking of 0.25 marks for the wrong answer.
- At least 50% marks are required to pass the exams, aggregate in both the session and 30% in individual subject.

## INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

As a student passes CPT exams, he need to register for Intermediate Some of the features of the course are:

- Registration for Intermediate will be done after passing CPT exams under which student has to appear in exams after the 9 months of registration.
- Examination comprises of 2 Groups with the following subjects :  
**Group-I:** (i) Accounting (ii) Law, Ethics and Communication (iii) Costing and Financial Management (iv) Taxation  
**Group-II:** (i) Advanced Accounting (ii) Auditing & Assurance (iii) Information Technology and Strategic Management
- To pass the same aggregate 50% marks are required in both the groups and 40% marks individually in each subjects.
- The registration fee for Intermediate course both group including Accounting Technician Course (ATC) certification is Rs. 10000/-
- Along with Intermediate Course, student have to complete 100 hrs Information Technology training and a week long orientation program which is conducted by ICAI chapters of the respective cities.
- A graduate and post graduate student from commerce stream with 55% marks and non commerce students with 60% marks can directly register in intermediate course.

## ARTICLESHIP TRAINING & FINAL LEVEL

After passing Group I or both Group of Intermediate examination, student have to register for practical training of 3 years under any practicing chartered accountant. Students can appear for the final exam after completing the training for 2.5 years. As they clear the final examination, complete the practical training and also General Management and Communication training they are qualified to become a member of ICAI.

**Company Secretary** is a professional whose role in a corporate set up is that of an advisor for legal matters. As per the Companies Act, a statutory requirement is that companies with a paid up share capital of a minimum of Rs.50 lakh are required to appoint a Company Secretary. Company Secretary is a very important member of the corporate management team.

## COMPANY SECRETARY COURSE AT A GLANCE

The company secretary course is divided into three programs:

1. Foundation 2. Executive 3. Professional

**Eligibility:** • 12th pass with any discipline

• Foundation Pass or Graduation with any discipline for executive course

### C.S. FOUNDATION PROGRAM

This is a gateway to the course of Company Secretary. A Student is eligible to register for the same after passing class X & can appear for the test after passing/appearing class XII.

Some of the features of the Course are: (as information received till this bulletin is printing)

- Student need to register for the course by filling a simple application from costing Rs. 50/- . The registration fee for the same is Rs. 4,500/-
- Exam will be held twice in a year (June, December). Cut off dates for getting registrations are as follows: For December Exams (31<sup>st</sup> March) & For June Exams (previous year's 30<sup>th</sup> September)
- All papers will be of objective type.
- Course will be comprises of four subjects viz
  - Business Environment and Entrepreneurship
  - Business Management, Ethics and Communication
  - Business Economics
  - Fundamentals of Accounting and Auditing.
- At least 50% marks aggregate are required to pass the exams and 40% in individual subject.
- Students cleared CPT exam can directly appear in CS-Executive exam.

### C.S. EXECUTIVE PROGRAM

After passing foundation exams or completing the graduation, a student can register with the institute for executive program. A students is then registered with the institute and he is required to complete the executive & professional program CA - CPT passed students is also eligible for CA Executive Course.

Course fee is Rs. 9000/- for commerce graduate student and Rs. 10000/- for Non-commerce graduate student and Rs. 8500/- for CS Foundation passed out student.
